Elizabeth finally arrived at Taiwanfoo, Formosa (now Tainan, Taiwan), to join her fiancé, Rev. Ferguson.

After a few months' work in Formosa, Elizabeth and Rev. Ferguson travelled to Hong Kong to marry and had their "working" honeymoon in Macao. A few days later, they returned to Tainan; Elizabeth opened her clinic in Sin-Lau Hospital.

Elizabeth and Rev. Ferguson often travelled around Southern Formosa, from the cities to the deep mountain's forests, to look after their patients and hold Sunday service.

Ùi chhim-soan nâ-lāi kàu tōa-to-chhī, chiàu-kờ hoān-chiá, ah-sī chú-chhì kàu-hōe lé-pài.
