Tâioânjī pán =bô liânjīhû (hyphen) ê Pehōejī

Sốí, tng in pàihóng soaⁿ lāi goânchūbîn kàuhōe ê sî, in ài chin sèjī. Mnā ài chùì tōngbut, mā ài chimchiok phahlah ê. Inūi in khólêng ē hông tòngchò tōngbut ah sī tekjîn, soah hō goânchūbîn tùi i khuichhèng.

Hókachài, inūi ū Ilīsapėk kah kîtha Sinlâu Pēⁿīⁿ ê iseng tàu chiàukò. Sòng boksu chiâⁿ kín toh hoehok kiānkhong, koh ētàng chìnhêng soankàu ê sūkang.

So when they visited the churches in the Taiwanese indigenous villages in the mountains, they had to be very careful. Besides the wild animals, they had to watch out for the hunters because they might accidentally shoot them when hunting in the dark or mistake them for enemies.

Luckily, with Elizabeth and the help of other doctors in Sin-Lau Hospital, Rev. Ferguson recovered quickly and mmediately returned to his missionary work.
