After nearly 140 days of travel, they arrived at Takao, Formosa (now Kaohsiung, Taiwan).Dr James Laidlaw Maxwell greeted them at the harbour and helped with their luggage.

"Finally! I have heard the sea between Formosa and Penghu Island is very dangerous. I am so glad you two arrived safely," he said.

"Thank you, Dr Maxwell. I see that the missionary building and the medical clinic are nearly done." replied Rev. Ritchie.

"Yes! It will be our first church and medical clinic in Formosa." Dr Maxwell replied.
